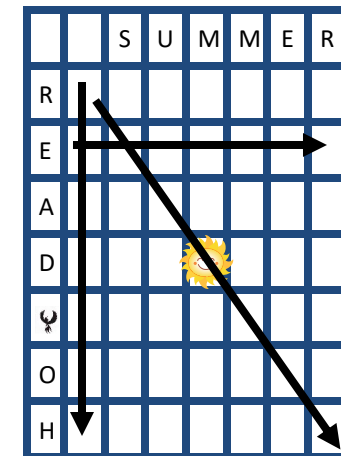
Fill in the entire "READ-OH" card to complete a "sun out". Everyone who completes a "sun out" will earn a special party in September.
